

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR COUNTY ADMINISTRATION FEES

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the County Commissioners of Boise County, Idaho,

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-870 provides that the County Commissioners of each county may impose and collect fees for those services provided by the County which would otherwise be funded by Ad Valorem Tax Revenues, and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners have determined that it would be in the best interest of the County to provide for a county administration fee to be paid by every vehicle registered in and through Boise County, Idaho.

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners have determined that a fee of \$1.50 is an Administration Fee not exceeding the actual cost of administration, and is reasonably related to the actual cost of the service being rendered.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BOISE COUNTY, IDAHO:

1. That in addition to the registration fee chargeable by the State of Idaho under Idaho Code §49-127, there is hereby imposed an additional Administration Fee of \$1.50 for each vehicle licensed through Boise County, Idaho, other than boats, off-road motorbikes, snowmobiles and recreational vehicle stickers.

2. That the \$1.50 fee shall be an annual fee payable at the same time as the current fee chargeable by the State.

That the revenues collected under the said fee shall be payable to the Current Expense Fund.

That it shall be unlawful for any owner of a vehicle to allow said vehicle to be driven upon the streets of Boise County, Idaho, without payment of said fee.

It shall be unlawful and punishable as a misdemeanor by a fine of not to exceed THREE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$300.00) DOLLARS, or by imprisonment in the County Jail of not to exceed six months or by both such fine and imprisonment for any person violating this Resolution.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the 1st day of July, 1988.
