RESOLUTION # 89-1

TO ESTABLISH AN OFFICIAL COUNTY CENTENNIAL COMMITTEE  
AND AUTHORIZE IT TO CONDUCT ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, the 1990 Idaho Centennial Commission is coordinating the statewide celebration of the state's 100th birthday in 1990, and encourage the formation of county centennial committees to plan activities to commemorate these events;

WHEREAS, funding and other assistance for state centennial planning and activities is available to counties from the 1990 Idaho Centennial Commission;

WHEREAS, people of Boise County wish to conduct planning activities and commemorative projects for the celebration of state centennial in Boise County;

WHEREAS, the Boise County Commissioners believe that the county should take the lead in establishing a comprehensive, coordinated program of centennial observances in the county that is open to all county residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Commissioners establish an official county centennial committee to serve as the prime coordinating body for local celebrations of the state centennial, and shall appoint members from the following groups and organizations . . .

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the official county centennial committee shall provide for an open, public process, including an appeals process, for the development of plans for the celebration of the state centennial and shall comply with all local, state, and federal civil rights and anti-discrimination laws and regulations in the conduct of its business and activities;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the county centennial committee submit to the county commissioners annually a program plan and budget for the expenditure of funds used exclusively for centennial purposes.
