

BOISE COUNTY EMERGENCY DECLARATION RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, fires have occurred in several areas of Boise County, and

WHEREAS, fire is currently burning in Boise County, threatening damage to property, particularly to several residences, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Boise County Board of Commissioners, and the Board of Commissioners finds:

- 1. An emergency is in existence in Boise County,
- 2. Private buildings, including residences are threatened,
- 3. An emergency exists which local, county and private resources may not be adequate to control,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved and declared by the Boise County, Idaho, Board of Commissioners, as follows:

- 1. An emergency exists within Boise County, resulting from existing and imminent danger to property, particularly residences.
- 2. Such emergency may require State and Federal emergency assistance to supplement local efforts to protect the public property and to avert and lessen the threat and impact of the emergency.
