

RESOLUTION NO. 92-7

RESOLUTION REQUIRING PERSONS HIRED AS PEACE OFFICERS TO REIMBURSE BOISE COUNTY THE COSTS OF WAGES AND BENEFITS PAID DURING THEIR TRAINING AT POST ACADEMY OR TO SERVE AS AN PEACE OFFICER FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR AFTER RECEIVING SAID CERTIFICATION.

WHEREAS, Section 19-5109, Idaho Code, provides that no Peace officer shall have or exercise any power granted by any statute of the State of Idaho to Peace Officers unless such person shall have been certified by the Idaho Peace Officer Standards and Training Council within one (1) year of the date upon which such person commenced employment as a Peace Officer;

AND WHEREAS, it would be an extreme hardship to require Peace officers who undergo training at the POST Academy in order to be certified to do so without receiving wages and benefits; and,

AND WHEREAS, if a Peace Officer employed by Boise County attends the POST Academy and is certified and then leaves the employment of Boise County within a short period of time, Boise County will have supported said Peace Officer during his training and not received the benefits of the training;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Boise County, Idaho, that all Peace Officers employed by Boise County who attend the POST Academy and during such attendance receive wages and benefits from Boise County, shall reimburse Boise County the amount of such wages and benefits unless they continue to serve Boise County as a Peace Officer for a period of time of at least one (1) year after the date of certification.


AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each Peace Officer shall be required to

sign a copy of this Resolution, to show that the Peace Officer agrees to reimburse Boise County the costs of wages and benefits paid during his training, unless the Peace Officer serves for a period of at least one (1) year after receiving the certification, in which case the Peace Officer will not have to reimburse Boise County.

Violations of the provisions of this Resolution shall give rise to a civil action which may be commenced by Boise County for restitution of any and all sums paid by Boise County for the wages and benefits paid during the Peace Officers training, plus costs and reasonable attorneys fees.
