

RESOLUTION 92-9

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners by Idaho Code are the governing board including jurisdiction over county roads; and

WHEREAS, Idaho code 49-1004 provides authority for a governing Board to issue special permits for overweight and oversize loads; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Road Department is currently working on a capitol project involving the re-building of a section of a Boise county road, also known as the Middlefork Road of the Payette River in the Garden Valley area; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Road Department is hauling loads of gravel with Boise County equipment and is also contracting with independent contractors for the hauling of loads of gravel; and


WHEREAS, the Boise County Road Department wishes to finish the project in a timely fashion; and

WHEREAS, weather constraints could impede the project completion if every effort is not made to expedite the project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners do hereby grant a special permit to the Boise County Road Department and all independent contractors hauling gravel for the Middlefork road project for the hauling of overweight loads for the completion of this capitol project.


