

RESOLUTION #93-1

WHEREAS The Board of Commissioners of Boise County, Idaho, have previously set the District Court budget for fiscal year 1991-1992; and

WHEREAS, it is apparent that the projections of expense calculated at the time the budgets were prepared are less than the expenses actually incurred because the amount of expenses the County is required by law to pay in connection with the Priest and Palmer murder trials are much greater than were anticipated; and

WHEREAS, no other monies exist within the county funds not needed for the purpose for which they were collected; and

WHEREAS, § 31-1608, Idaho Code, provides for the issuance of registered warrants to meet mandatory expenses required by law; and


WHEREAS an emergency exists;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a Warrant Redemption Fund be established to pay the ordinary and necessary expenses incurred in the operation of the District Court fund and that a registered warrant be issued to Bank of America in the amount of Fifty


Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$50,000.00), such registered warrant to bear interest at the rate of 6% per annum.
