

Resolution No. 18-93

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners have the responsibility under Idaho Code to maintain certain roads within the County, and

WHEREAS, the Banks-Lowman Road identified as Highway 17 is maintained by Boise County and listed on the County Road system, and

WHEREAS, the Crouch Bridge across the Middle Fork of the Payette River is a part of this particular road, and

WHEREAS, a recent bridge inspection has found it necessary to limit use of the bridge and proceed immediately to repair structural damage to said bridge, and


WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners have the authority under Idaho Code to declare an emergency when an imminent threat to public safety is determined.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners hereby declare that a Public Safety Emergency exists and that appropriate steps be taken to correct this emergency as quickly as possible.
