

RESOLUTION NO. 94-7

RESOLUTION ADOPTING BOISE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, Idaho Local Planning Act, Idaho Code Title 67, Chapter 65, requires Idaho counties to carry out planning duties necessary for the development of a comprehensive plan, and

WHEREAS, Boise County, pursuant to court order and with the participation of residents and land owners in the County, has prepared a draft comprehensive plan, and

WHEREAS, public hearings have been held within the County in compliance with provisions of the Local Planning Act, and

WHEREAS, the participation of residents and land owners and the assistance of volunteer efforts have enabled the production of a workable Comprehensive Plan, and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Boise County as follows:

1. That the Board of Commissioners hereby adopts as the Comprehensive Plan for Boise County that Draft Comprehensive Plan consisting of seventy-two (72) bound pages, plus a pocketed Generalized Land Use Map, dated July 29, 1994. Said adopted draft is a final print of prior drafts which have been the subject of public hearings referenced above and which reflect responses to public comments upon prior meeting of the Board on August 1, 1994. The Board hereby determines that said modification are minor and do not constitute material changes to the adopted draft.

2. Three copies of said Plan shall be maintained on file in the office of the Boise County Clerk. Individual copies may be purchased for the cost of production from the Boise County Clerk.

This Resolution is ADOPTED AND EFFECTIVE this 1st day of August, 1994.
