

RESOLUTION NO. 96-10

ROBIE CREEK ROAD BRIDGE PURCHASE

WHEREAS; Title 31-805 of the Idaho Code gives the County Commissioners supervision over roads, bridges and ferries within their jurisdiction. The section requires the Commissioners to layout, maintain, control, and manage public roads, turnpikes, ferried, and bridges within the county and levy such tax thereof as authorize by law; and,

WHEREAS; the Robie Creek Bridge over Mores Creek is rated in the worst conditions of any bridge in the Boise County Road System, having a sufficiency rating of 13.8 in 1992; and,

WHEREAS; the cost for replacing the bridge exceeds the bid limit requirement under Idaho Code Section 40-906; and,

WHEREAS; the expenditure requires Boise County to comply with Title 40-901, Idaho Code for bidding a replacement bridge; and,

WHEREAS; Boise County published a Notice of Bid, in the Idaho World, on May 22 and June 12, 1886; and,

WHEREAS; Boise County received no bids as required on June 24, 1996 at the time of 10:00 a.m.; and,

WHEREAS; Idaho Code Section 40-912 allows for the negotiation of purchase of materials when no bids are received; and,

WHEREAS; a 90' by 37' - 4" bridge presently exists as a temporary structure on the Cole/Overland, Federal-Aid Project, in Boise, Idaho; and,

WHEREAS; contractor has offered to sell these bridges for sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) or eighteen dollars (\$18) per square foot; and,

WHEREAS; said bridge would be acceptable for use on the Robie Creek Road crossing of Mores Creek

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that Boise county enter into negotiations with McAlvain Construction for the purchase of one, 90' by 37' -4" wide, precast, prestressed, concrete, single T-beam Bridge, with precast concrete diaphragm, connecting rod, deck, bearing pads, and guard rail included; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said contract McAlvain Construction is an Idaho domiciled contractor, and Boise County is complying with Idaho Code Section 67-2348, giving preference for Idaho domiciled contractors.
