

RESOLUTION NO. 96-2

A RESOLUTION OF BOISE COUNTY, IDAHO, FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING ON THE LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 95-1 ASSESSMENT ROLL; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND MAILING OF NOTICE THEREOF; REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 96-1; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO

WHEREAS, Local Improvement District No. 95-1 ("L.I.D. No. 95-1") of Boise County, Idaho (the "County"), was created by Ordinance No. 95-1, adopted by the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of the County on April 3, 1995; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ordinance No. 95-1, the improvements within L.I.D. No. 95-1 have been completed, and Holladay Engineering Co., as engineer for L.I.D. No. 95-1, has submitted a report showing in detail the total cost and expenses of the improvements, the dollar amount thereof payable from assessments, and a form of assessment roll showing the amount chargeable to each lot or parcel of property subject to assessment within L.I.D. No. 95-1; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the legal description of the boundaries of L.I.D. No. 95-1, as described in Ordinance No. 95-1, inadvertently omitted certain properties intended to be included in and which are benefitted by the improvements within L.I.D. No. 95-1, and the Board desires to conduct a hearing on the question of including such omitted property in L.I.D. No. 95-1 and to amend Ordinance No. 95-1 to include such omitted property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BOISE COUNTY, IDAHO, as follows:

Section 1: The form of assessment roll for L.I.D. No. 95-1, prepared by Holladay Engineering Co., shall be filed in the office of the County Clerk, where it shall be available for public inspection during normal business hours.

Section 2: Monday, the 18th day of December, 1995, at the hour of 10:00 A.M., at the regular meeting place of the Board, at the Boise County Courthouse, Idaho City, Idaho, is hereby fixed as the date, time, and place when and where the Board will meet in open session for the purpose of (1) amending Ordinance No. 95-1 to include certain inadvertently omitted parcels of property within L.I.D. No. 95-1, and (2) considering the engineer's report on the assessment roll and hearing any objections to the assessment roll by the owners of property within L.I.D. No. 95-1.

Section 3: The County Clerk shall give notice of the hearing specified in Section 2 above by publication of notice, substantially in the form set forth in Exhibit "A" which is annexed

hereto and by reference made a part of this resolution, in the official newspaper of the County, once a week for two successive weeks, the first such publication being at least fifteen (15) days before the date fixed for hearing objections to the assessment roll. The County Clerk shall also, not less than fifteen (15) days before the date fixed for hearing objections to the assessment roll, mail notice of the hearing, substantially in the form set forth in Exhibit "B" which is annexed hereto and by reference made a part of this resolution, to each owner of property, if known, or his or her agent, if known, within the limits of L.I.D. No. 95-1, addressed to such person at his or her post office address, if known, or, if unknown, to the main post office in Garden Valley, Idaho. The mailed notice shall state the amount of the individual assessment as shown on the preliminary assessment roll.

Section 4: The owner or owners of any property which is assessed in said assessment roll, whether named in said assessment roll or not, may, within the time specified in the notice before the date and time fixed for the hearing, file with the County Clerk his or her objections in writing to said assessment.

Section 5: Resolution No. 96-1, adopted on October 30, 1995, is hereby repealed.
