

DISASTER DECLARATION RESOLUTION # 96-4

WHEREAS, snow has and continues to accumultate in most areas of Boise County, Idaho and

WHEREAS, snow has accumulated in unprecendented amounts and county road clearing equipment is inadequate to keep county roads clear, particularly in the eastern and northern portions of the County, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Boise County Board of Commissioners, and the Board of Commissioners finds:

1. An emergency, as defined in Section 46-1002, Idaho Code, is in existence in Boise County,
2. Some public roads are closed and continued snowfall will force others to close, forcing cessation of emergency services and radio communications,
3. An emergency exists which local county and private resources are inadequate to control, and Federal and State assistance is required, pursuant to Title 46, Chapter 10 Idaho Code, and other State and Federal laws pertaining to disaster emergencies and assistance.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved and declared by the Boise County Idaho Board of Commissioners, as follows:

1. A disaster emergency exists within Boise County, resulting from severe snow storms and imminent danger and damage to property, particularly residences, mobile homes, churches, schools, municipal water supplies and farmland.
2. Such disaster requires State and Federal emergency assistance to supplement local efforts to protect, rehabilitate and replace public property and to avert and lessen the threat and impact of the disaster. In particular, snow removal within the City of Idaho City.
3. The Boise County Board of Commissioners request that the Governor of the State of Idaho, together with other appropriate State officials, together with other

appropriate Federal officials, make such Declarations,
and provide such assistance within Boise County as are
required and allowed by law.

Adopted unanimously, in open, regular session this twenty
ninth day of January, 1996, by those Commissioners subscribing
their names hereto.


