

RESOLUTION NO. #97-13
BOISE COUNTY DECLARATION OF INTENT
TO ABANDON AND VACATE the SOUTH FORK THORN CREEK ROAD

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners declared a State of Disaster on December 30, 1996, due to winter storm damage; and,

WHEREAS, the South Fork Thorn Creek Road, was totally washed out by the winter storms and in part was essentially reclaimed as a valley from wall to wall; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency has estimated partial costs to repair and rebuild the roadway in excess of \$640,000; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners consider this section of roadway no longer to be in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Boise County, Idaho, as follows:

I. Based upon the foregoing, the Board of Commissioners intend to abandon and vacate the South Fork Thorn Creek Road, as described:

US Forest Service Road #377, at a beginning point 4.1 miles from State Highway 21, T5N, R5E, SW 1/4 Sec 27, continuing to the Middle Fork of the Boise River Road.

II. That a Public Hearing be set in accordance with Idaho Code §40-203.


III. The employees and staff of Boise County are hereby authorized to carry out the responsibilities set forth for notice procedures according to Idaho Code §40-203.

IV. Effective Date: This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon its passage by the Board of Commissioners of Boise County.


