

**RESOLUTION #97-26**

**A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE BOISE COUNTY BUDGET TO REFLECT THE RECEIPT OF UNSCHEDULED REVENUE TO THE 911 SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, Boise County will receive funds from multiple utility companies for 911 telephone service; and

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §31-1605 allows the Board of County Commissioners to adjust the budget to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue from State, Federal, and private agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment, and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that monies received for the purpose of the 911 telephone system be budgeted as follows:


Anticipated Revenue	\$34,558.61


