**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BUSINESS DAYS AND
TIMES FOR VARIOUS COUNTY OFFICES**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners under Idaho Code 31-2009 has the authority to set the offices' hours of the various county offices at the county seat and prescribe what hours and on such days as the various offices will be open, and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners to the greatest extent possible wish to establish uniformity among the various offices and provide maximum services to the citizens of Boise County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that effective immediately the office hours at the County seat of the Recorder, Treasurer, Assessor, Sheriff, District Court and the Prosecuting Attorney shall be open as follows:

**MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY
DAILY (Except Holidays)**

8:00 A.M. TO 12:00 NOON
1:00 P.M. TO 5:00 P.M.



31-2009. Offices to be kept at the county seat - Office hours.

Sheriffs, recorders, treasurers, assessor, and in counties having a population of over 7,500, prosecuting attorneys must have their offices at the county seat, and keep them open for the transaction of business on such days and during such hours as the boards of county commissioners may prescribe. Provided, that in counties having a population of 7,500 or less, the prosecuting attorney must have an office at the county seat and must, by and with the approval of the board of county commissioners, establish such rules and hours for official business as may be necessary for the dispatch thereof.
