

RESOLUTION #98-15

A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE BOISE COUNTY BUDGET TO REFLECT THE RECEIPT OF UNSCHEDULED REVENUE TO THE JUSTICE FUND BUDGET:

WHEREAS, the Boise County Sheriff's department has received unanticipated funds from FISK and State Training Grants in the amount of \$13,558.72; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 31-1605 allows the Board of County Commissioners to adjust the budget to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue from State and Federal Agencies;


WHEREAS, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustments, and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$13,558.72 will be placed in the Boise County Justice Fund Budget as follows:




