

RESOLUTION #98-4

BOISE COUNTY DECLARATION OF INTENT
TO ABANDON AND VACATE THE GRIMES PASS ROAD

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners declared a State of Disaster on December 30, 1996, due to winter storm damage; and,

WHEREAS, the Grimes Pass Road, from the summit down the north side to the South Fork road.,approximately 3,800 feet, was substantially washed out by the winter storms; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has estimated partial costs to repair and rebuild the roadway in excess of \$80,000; and

WHEREAS, FEMA in a letter dated September 25, 1997, has under Executive Orders 11988 & 11990 decided not to fund restoration of the Grimes Pass Road; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners consider this section of roadway may no longer to be in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Boise County, Idaho, as follows:

- I. Based upon the foregoing, the Board of Commissioners intend to abandon and vacate the Grimes Pass Road, as described:


commencing at the intersection of the South Fork Road and Grimes Pass Road and terminating at the intersection of Grimes Pass Road and Golden Age Mine Road, Boise County, Idaho, more closely described as a county road commencing in the SW1/4, SEC. 10, T8N, R5E, and continuing into the NW 1/4, SEC 15, T8N, R5E, the SW 1/4 SEC 15, T8N, R5E and the SE 1/4, SEC 15, T8N, R5E and terminating in the NE 1/4 SEC 22, T8N, R5E, B.M.

- II. That a Public Hearing be set in accordance with Idaho Code 40-203.


- III. The employees and staff of Boise county are hereby authorized to carry out the responsibilities set forth for notice procedures according to Idaho Code 40-203.

IV. Effective Date: This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon its passage by the Board of Commissioner of Boise County.




