

RESOLUTION #98-5A

RESOLUTION ORDERING TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE ROAD AND BRIDGE FUND TO JUSTICE FUND TO MEET EXPENDITURES UNTIL PROPERTY TAXES ARE COLLECTED:

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Idaho Code § 31-1508 the Boise County Board of Commissioners do find that there was an unforeseen need for cash arising from the operations of the JUSTICE FUND that could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of preparing the budget; and

WHEREAS, this operational cost will require the transfer of monies not provided for in the budget and demands for expenditures will not exceed appropriations, and at the time property taxes are collected these funds will be transferred back to the Road and Bridge Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it Resolved, that the Boise County Board of County Commissioners, by unanimous vote, do hereby order a transfer of funds as follows:

Transfer of \$80,500.00 From the Road and Bridge Fund to the Justice Fund until such time that property taxes are collected and at that time transfer \$80,500.00 from the Justice Fund to the Road and Bridge Fund.






