**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT
CREATING THE IDAHO CAPITAL CRIMES DEFENSE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners met on the 19th day of October to consider the Joint Powers Agreement establishing the Idaho Capital Crimes Defense Program as provided by I.C. §19-863A; and


WHEREAS, the County is responsible for providing criminal defense of indigent person for which the County is obligated pursuant to the provision of title 19, chapter 8, Idaho Code; and


WHEREAS, the Board has considered the extreme financial hardship the cost of providing a defense in capital crimes creates on the County's budget; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Boise County enter into that certain Joint Powers Agreement dated October 19, 1998, which creates the Idaho Capital Crimes Defense Program for the counties of the state of Idaho, and that Commissioner John N. Dyer, acting as Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, be and is hereby authorized and instructed to affix his name to the Joint Powers Agreement on behalf of Boise County.


