RESOLUTION #99-2

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING BOISE COUNTY SURPLUS REAL PROPERTY TO THE CROUCH VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE SERVICE, INC.

WHEREAS, the real property (land) on which the existing Crouch Volunteer Ambulance Service Inc. building is situated is owned by Boise County and was acquired at no cost to Boise County taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the same property was acquired solely for the use of the Crouch Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Crouch Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc. now requires a two bay building, which the existing property will not accommodate; and

WHEREAS, the Garden Valley Rural Fire Department has made available a suitable site for the construction of a new two bay ambulance building for the Crouch Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners do deem the real property on which the current Crouch Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc. building is situated to be surplus real property to the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Boise County deed title to the real property on which the Crouch Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc. building is situated to the Crouch Volunteer Ambulance Service, Inc.; for the sole and express purpose of selling in order to raise money to build a two bay ambulance building at the Garden Valley Rural Fire Department site.
