

RESOLUTION #99-23

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BOISE COUNTY POLICY ON THE ASSOCIATION OF PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS OFFICIALS 25 (APCO 25) COMMUNICATION STANDARD

WHEREAS; advancements in communication technology make it necessary to adopt a communications equipment standard; and

WHEREAS, federal, state and local agencies are adopting a communications equipment standard that will bridge the gap between analog and digital communication services; and

WHEREAS, the communication standard being adopted by federal, state and local agencies is the Association of Public Safety Communications Officials 25 (APCO 25) communication standard; also known as APCO Project 25, P25, Project 25 Standard, or EIA/TIA-102 Digital Narrowband; and

WHEREAS, Boise County desires to maintain communication capability with federal, state and local agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Boise County hereby adopts the APCO 25 communication standard for all Boise County replacement radios and communication equipment purchased from this day forward.
