

RESOLUTION #99-3

**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE LOCAL RESPONSE AUTHORITY
FOR HAZARDOUS INCIDENTS WITHIN BOISE COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the State of Idaho adopted Senate Bill 1130, the Hazardous Substance Emergency Response Act, and is pursuing the creation of regional response teams for hazardous substance incidents; and

WHEREAS, these state supported teams will be fully trained and equipped to respond to serious chemical accidents; and

WHEREAS, in order to clarify and simplify Idaho's current hazardous materials response capabilities, the Act requires local governments to designate "local emergency response authority" for hazardous substance incidents; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Boise County Commissioners believes the contact person should be the Boise County Disaster Service Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, the State will provide the necessary and proper training regarding hazardous material, programs, and such;




