A RESOLUTION ADOPTING VOLUNTARY  
FIRE PROTECTION GUIDELINES FOR RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT  
IN THE URBAN-WILDLAND INTERFACE

WHEREAS, Boise County is interested in providing voluntary guideline standards for the safeguarding of life and property within the county; and


WHEREAS, the guidelines are intended to mitigate the risk of life and structures from intrusion of fire from wildland fire exposures, and fire exposure from adjacent structures, and to mitigate structure fires from spreading to wildland fuels; and

WHEREAS, the guidelines are for information to interested residences of the county;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Boise County, Idaho hereby adopt the "Fire Protection Guidelines for Residential Development in the Urban-Wildland Interface" for public information, and that copies be provided by the Planning and Zoning Department with each building permit issued; and, copies be available in the Recorder's Office.

APPROVED AND ADOPTED by the Boise County Board of Commissioners in open session on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of September 1999.


