



BOISE COUNTY SOLID WASTE

DISPOSAL OF EXTRAORDINARY LARGE ITEMS

The Warmsprings (Idaho City), Garden Valley and Lowman Transfer Stations will NOT accept extraordinary large items for disposal such as:

Campers

Camp trailers

Hot Tubs

Boats

Pickup toppers (camper shells)

And like items, THIS LIST IS NOT ALL INCLUSIVE, does not include Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D) and items disassembled or cut to lengths less than 6 feet. If you intend to disassemble or cut up extraordinary large items; you must do so before bringing them to the Boise County Transfer Stations.

You may take extraordinary large items directly to the Horseshoe Bend Transfer Station, 201 Old Emmett Rd. off Highway 55 at Horseshoe Bend. The transfer station is open Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, 9 am to 5 pm. The disposal fee will be based on weight of the item, at the current price for Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D) PLUS the estimated time required to crush or disassemble the item for disposal, at the current contract hourly rate for equipment and operator. The Horseshoe Bend Transfer Station may refuse your waste in which case you will need to make disposal arrangements directly with a landfill.
