



BOISE COUNTY SOLID WASTE **DISPOSAL OF LIVESTOCK MANURE**

Boise County Transfer Stations do not accept livestock manure for disposal.

Manure may contain parasites and pathogens which can infect other animals. Manure is a prime breeding ground for flies and other insects which may become disease vectors or nuisances. Run off water from manure contains excess nutrients and other contaminants that may get into surface and ground water.

Disposal of manure in a Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Landfill is a costly and arduous process for residents of Boise County to hire a truck to haul the manure to landfills in either Payette or Elmore County. Boise County does not have a MSW Landfill. It is the responsibility of the person generating the waste to ensure it is properly disposed of. Idaho Solid Waste Rules (IDAPA 58.01.06) exempts Manures that are "ultimately returned to the soils at agronomic rates". The best management practice for manure is to spread and till the manure into an agricultural field.

If you cannot spread and till your manure into a field or pasture, it may hauled directly to a MSW Landfill or compost facility.

Poultry and domestic animals are not livestock and their litter / feces may be bagged and disposed of in dumpsters.
