



BOISE COUNTY SOLID WASTE

DISPOSAL OF RECHARGABLE BATTERIES

Boise County accepts household batteries at each of the transfer stations. Acceptable batteries include the following battery types that are generated by households or individual use and are not generated by commercial businesses. Businesses that generate waste batteries should make arrangements for recycling or disposal through their suppliers.

Rechargeable Batteries:

Lithium-Ion, Nickel Cadmium (NiCd), Nickel Metal Hydride (NiMH), and sealed lead acid batteries. These are commonly found in cell phones, laptops, toys, cordless tools and radios. These may be placed in a designated bucket for collection. These are recycled through commercial battery wholesalers or battery take back programs.

Automotive Batteries:

Wet cell lead acid batteries commonly used in automobiles, motorcycles, ATVs, ride on toys and equipment. These are placed on a pallet and recycled through commercial battery wholesalers.

Alkaline and Carbon Batteries are single use and not rechargeable or recyclable. These may be disposed of in the regular household waste.
