## DISPOSAL OF LAND CLEARING DEBRIS, STUMPS AND LOGS

## Horseshoe Bend and Lowman Transfer Stations do not accept stumps and logs from trees greater than 12" (twelve inches)

Land Clearing Debris is defined as wood and brush with a diameter greater than 4 inches or with roots attached. Stumps and logs from trees greater than 12 inches in diameter may be disposed of at the Garden Valley and Idaho City (Warmsprings) Transfer Stations. Access to the brush piles at the transfer stations is weather dependent and typically open April through November. The Horseshoe Bend and Lowman Transfer Stations do not have the capacity to accept large stumps and logs from land clearing. The Land Clearing Debris charge of \$2.00 per cubic yard will apply and be paid at the transfer station accepting your waste.
