



# BOISE COUNTY

## RESOLUTION #2024-29

### A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BOISE COUNTY:

- **Making certain Findings; and**
- **In consideration of the filed Petition to create a new East Boise County EMS District, declaring intent to consider dissolution of the East Boise County Ambulance District with the plan of dissolution subject to process and conditions precedent as required by law; and**
- **Setting public hearings and process to be followed; and**
- **Directing the County Clerk; and**
- **Providing an Effective Date.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Boise County:

#### **Section 1: Findings**

It is hereby found by the Board of County Commissioners of Boise County that:

- 1.1** *A Petition To Form An Ambulance Service District And To Dissolve East Boise County Ambulance District* has been duly filed with the County Clerk pursuant to Idaho Code Sections 31-3911 and 31-3908(1) (f) by over 50 qualified Boise County Elector Petitioners residing within the boundaries of the proposed East Boise County EMS District (the "Petition"). Along with the Petition, the Petitioners filed certified resolutions of the City Council of the City of Idaho City and the City of Placerville consenting to participate in the new East Boise County EMS District and consenting, if the voters approve the formation of a new East Boise County EMS District, to the Board of County Commissioners dissolving the existing East Boise County Ambulance District; and
- 1.2** Pursuant to Idaho Code Section 31-3908(1)(f) and 31-3907, the Board of County Commissioners has the authority to dissolve the existing East Boise County Ambulance District by following the public hearing and notice requirements of Idaho Code Section 31-3908(1)(c).

#### **Section 2: Intention to dissolve East Boise County Ambulance District subject to conditions precedent as required by law:**

- 2.1** The Board of Commissioners of Boise County, in consideration of the filed Petition, does hereby declare its intent to consider the dissolution of the East Boise County Ambulance District subject to the following process and conditions as set forth in this section as required by law.

- 2.2** The Board of Commissioners does hereby set two public hearings (one for creation of a new East Boise County EMS District, and one to consider intent to consider dissolution of the existing East Boise County Ambulance District) and directs the County Clerk to publish this Resolution and the Petition together with the notice of the joint hearings, in accordance with Idaho Code Sections 31-3908(1)(c) and (f) , and 31-3911(4) which hearings will be held at the Miners Exchange Building, Commissioner Meeting Room at 420 Main Street, Idaho City, Idaho 83631, commencing at: \_\_\_\_\_ p.m. or as soon thereafter as these hearings are convened by the County Board of Commissioners. Interested persons have the right to appear at the public hearing and have an opportunity to be heard on these matters.
- 2.3** If, after due consideration, following the conduct of the public hearing on the Petition, the Board of Commissioners determines to grant the Petition, it shall publish notice of and call for a special election on the question.
- 2.4** If a majority of the electors at the special election, to create a new East Boise County EMS District, vote “yes”, the Board of Commissioners will approve a resolution to dissolve the East Boise County Ambulance District pursuant to a plan of dissolution providing for the payment of all outstanding debts and expenses with any remaining assets to be transferred to the new ambulance service district upon its formation.

**Section 3: Direction to County Clerk**

- 4.1** The County Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution and the Petition together with the notice of the joint hearings as herein set, in accordance with Idaho Code Sections 31-3908(1)(c) and (f) and 31-3911(4); and
- 4.2** Retain this resolution in the official records of the County Commissioners and to provide a certified copy to any person who requests it subject the payment of a certification fee.

**Section 5: Effective Date.**


- 5.1** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval.




