Chairman Tucker called the meeting to order.

Representatives of COMPASS (Community Planning Association of Southern Idaho) discussed with the Road & Bridge Department what the plans were, for Boise County roads. They would need more encompassing data such as how many travel on Boise County roads and what the County's needs are for infrastructure. What are the highest priorities for Boise County? Road & Bridge Superintendent Braughton stated that rock mitigation along MM26, Banks/Lowmand Rd, and the guard rails are in bad shape. Also, some bridges that are needing work. COMPASS stated that they would need documents reflecting the Road & Bridge Department's budget, maintenance of equipment, payroll, etc.

Chairman Tucker explained how they were going to be giving the COMPASS representatives a tour of Boise County roads.

Chairman Tucker adjourned the meeting until the regular meeting of April 8th, 2025.


