A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE FY 2025 GENERAL FUND, EMERGENCY MANAGER DEPARTMENT, FOR THE 2024 SHSP GRANT BUDGET AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the FY 2025 budget, for the Boise County General Fund, Emergency Management Department budget, was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on September 3rd, 2024, via Resolution 2024-36; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 31-1605 allows the Board of County Commissioners to adjust the budget, as adopted, to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue, grants, or donations from federal, state or local governments or private sources, provided that there shall be no increase in anticipated property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the General Fund, Emergency Management Department, will receive unanticipated revenue and has incurred unanticipated expense, associated with the 2024 SHSP grant, awarded by the Idaho Office of Emergency Management, Federal Grant Award #EMW-2024-SS-05016/CFDA #97.067, for professional services provided as part of an emergency training exercise for emergency responders within Boise County; and

WHEREAS, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the FY 2025 General Fund, Emergency Management Department budget, is adjusted as follows:
