OFFICIAL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

IN ATTENDANCE: Chairman Tucker, Commissioner Lindstrom, Commissioner Callahan, Clerk Prisco, Deputy Clerk Mayo, Auditor Nopens, Assessor Juszcak and Sheriff Tuner.

Commissioner Lindstrom called the Special Meeting to order and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

DISCUSSION OF TENTATIVE BUDGET FY26: Clerk Prisco presented to the Board, a preliminary FY2026 Tentative Budget, which will need to be submitted for publication in the Idaho World by Friday, August 8th. The preliminary tentative budget presented included the following components:

- Quartile changes (recognizing years of service) for employees who are scheduled to advance quartiles effective October 1st, 2025, due to achieving a certain level of years of service within their position.
- A Cost of Living increase of 3% for all employees, effective October 1st, 2025, based on the most recent CPI (Consumer Price Index) increase (June 2024 to June 2025) of 2.7% per information obtained from the Idaho Department of Labor.
- A proposed percentage of the total amount required for the full time elected officers, who are under compensated from the market rate, based on their years of service as an officer of the County.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to move into executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(b) personnel. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED. Roll call vote: Chairman Tucker – Aye; Commissioner Lindstrom – Aye; Commissioner Callahan – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Clerk Prisco, Auditor Nopens, Prosecuting Attorney Sosa and Sheriff Turner were present in executive session.



Chairman Tucker brought the meeting out of executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(b) personnel. Commissioner Callahan directed the Clerk's Office on changes in percentages used for elected officials' compensation, and changes in levels within the Kinds/Levels chart, for positions within: Sheriff's Department (Civil Deputies), Prosecuting Attorney's Office (Administrative Assistant), and for the Wildfire Mitigation Department (Manager and Forester positions).

Commissioner Lindstrom adjourned the meeting until the regular meeting of Tuesday, August 5th, 2025.
