OFFICIAL EMERGENCY MEETING MINUTES

Commissioner Callahan called the meeting to order.

A special meeting was held per Idaho Code 74-204(2) and put on record that an emergency exists under this statute, due to the failure of the water system for the City of Idaho City, and which involves immediate financial loss or the likelihood of injury, damage, or loss, which would make earlier notice impracticable. Commissioner Callahan also stated that he had received word that Horseshoe Bend could possibly have the same issue as Idaho City in the near future.

Chairman Tucker MOTIONED to declare a local disaster emergency under Idaho Code 46-1011(1) due to the failure of the water system in Idaho City which constitutes an emergency. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes.

Commissioner Callahan adjourned the meeting until September 2nd, 2025.
