TUESDAY, MARCH 10th, 2026
IDAHO CITY COMMISSIONER ROOM
OFFICIAL MEETING MINUTES

IN ATTENDANCE: Chairman Tucker, Commissioner Lindstrom, Commissioner Callahan, Clerk Prisco, Deputy Clerk Mayo, Human Resource Director Dexter, Sheriff Turner, Wildfire Mitigation Administrator Jones, Community Justice Administrator Leader, Treasurer Turner and Assessor Juszczak.

Chairman Tucker called the meeting to order and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

CONSTITUENT INPUT: None at this time.

MINUTES: Minutes for the March 3rd, 2026 meeting was presented to the Board. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve the minutes for March 3rd, 2026 meeting. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes.

DEPARTMENTAL ISSUES: Treasurer Turner brought in front of the Board a Tax Cancellation, review and discussion ensued. Chairman Tucker abstained himself because the request was for a family member. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve Tax Cancellation for MH09N04E264352 in the amount of \$152.29. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Planning & Zoning had a road name change request in front of the Board, discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve the road name change request RN2026-002 to Whisper Creek. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Sheriff Turner had in front of the Board the Stancil Software upgrade for the dispatch location, review and discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve the request for Boise County Sheriff's Office for the Stancil upgrade, from West Tek Marketing, in the amount of \$30,780.00. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Emergency Manager Jones brought in front of the Board the AIM Grant for presentation, along with Ms. Melisa Lindros with the Lowman Wildfire Mitigation Partnership, who wrote the Grant in coordination with Mr. Jones and Wildfire Mitigation Coordinator Barkalow. Ms. Lindros spoke of the cost and the 100% in-kind match. The idea behind it is to create a Wildfire Mitigation Neighborhood Ambassador Program for Lowman, discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve the AIM Grant. Commissioner Lindstrom RESCINDED his last motion. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to accept the AIM Grant Award and sign Attachment C (conflict of interest form). Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Mr. Jones asked that the Board table the Dashboard Mobile Assessment discussion until the March 17, 2026 meeting.

Assessor Juszczak addressed the Board in recognizing Mr. Jason Rowe, Deputy Assessor and Mapper for Boise County, for his dedicated 20 years of service. Mr. Rowe has presented map related evidence not only for the Courts, but most if not all of the other Boise County Offices. Mr. Juszczak presented Mr. Rowe with a plaque in the shape of Boise County and with the Boise County seal.

Noxious Weeds Superintendent Forsea brought in front of the Board a new employee hire, discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve this payroll addition change to Kari Allred in the amount of \$18.00/hr. at 20 hours per week or less. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Clerk Prisco brought in front of the Board the IDPR (Idaho Department of Parks & Recreation) Request for Reimbursement and Close-out Report for an IC8A Snowmobile Program grant (Trail Maintenance &

Clearing), discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve the Request for Reimbursement and Close-out Report to the Idaho Department of Parks & Recreation in the amount of \$4,349.43. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes.

CONTRACTS/AGREEMENTS/GRANTS/RESOLUTIONS: Community Justice Administrator Leader had in front of the Board the Central District Health Sub-grant Agreement, discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve CDH Sub-grant agreement in the amount of \$3,750.00. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Clerk Prisco had in front of the Board Resolution 2026-18 Boise County Social Media Policy, discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve Resolution 2026-18, a Boise County resolution adopting a Boise County Social Media Policy. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes.

CORRESPONDENCE: The bills/claims were presented to the Board for review and approval. Discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to pay the bills/claims in the amount of \$237,806.88. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes.

Coroner's Office had a demand warrant in front of the Board. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve this demand warrant to Michael Johnson in the amount of \$733.86. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes.

Roll call vote: Chairman Tucker – Aye; Commissioner Lindstrom – Aye; Commissioner Callahan – Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Clerk Prisco and Human Resource Director Dexter were present in executive session. Chairman Tucker brought the meeting out of executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(i), risk management, no action required.

Mr. Jack Hurty with the Idaho Outfitters and Guides Association came to speak to the Board to get their perspective on the issues with public lands and potential resolutions. Commissioners and other Department Heads and Elected Officials discussed numerous issues including: USFS, grazing, search and rescue incidents, rafting and wolf issues.

Clerk Prisco and Human Resource Director Dexter were present in executive session. Chairman Tucker brought the meeting out of executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(b), personnel and 74-206(1)(i), risk management, no action required.
