A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION AMENDING THE REGIONAL MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners have reviewed the EMS Multi-Mitigation Plan, adopted as Resolution #2018-25; and

WHEREAS, a diligent review and discussion of an amended EMS Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, has been accomplished by the Board of Boise County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, areas of Boise County are vulnerable to the human and economic costs of natural, technological and societal disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners realizes the importance of reducing or eliminating those vulnerabilities for the overall good and welfare of Boise County; and

WHEREAS, Boise County has been an active participant in the Boise County All Hazard Mitigation Task Force, which has established a comprehensive, coordinated planning process to eliminate or decrease these vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, Boise County representatives and staff have identified, justified and prioritized a number of proposed projects and programs needed to mitigate the vulnerabilities of unincorporated areas of Boise County to the impacts of future disasters; and

WHEREAS, these proposed projects and programs have been incorporated into this edition of the Boise County Multi-Jurisdiction All Hazard Mitigation Plan that has been prepared and issued for consideration and implementation by the communities and jurisdictions of Boise County; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Boise County Board of Commissioners does rescind Boise County Resolution #2018-25; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Boise County hereby accepts and approves of its designated portion of the Amended Boise County Multi-Jurisdiction All Hazard Mitigation Plan; the agency personnel of Boise County are requested and instructed to pursue available funding opportunities for implementation of the proposal designated therein; the agencies and organizations within Boise County will upon receipt of such funding or other necessary resources seek to implement the proposals contained in its section of the strategy; Boise County will continue to participate in the updating and expansion of the Boise County Multi-Jurisdiction All Hazard Mitigation Plan in the years ahead; and Boise County will further seek to encourage the businesses, industries and community groups operating within Boise

County to also participate in the updating and expansion of the Boise County Multi-Jurisdiction All Hazard Mitigation Plan in the years ahead.
