OFFICIAL MEETING MINUTES

IN ATTENDANCE: Chairman Tucker, Commissioner Lindstrom, Commissioner Callahan, Clerk Prisco, Deputy Clerk Mayo, Human Resource Director Dexter, Prosecuting Attorney Sosa, Planning & Zoning Assistant Morrison, Road & Bridge Superintendent Braughton, Grant Writer Robison, Community Justice Administrator Leader and Assessor Juszcak.

Chairman Tucker called the meeting to order and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

CONSTITUENT INPUT: Mr. Bobby Matthews with Idaho City Council had questions as to who owns Elk Creek Road, County or the City? Due to an issue that arose during the Idaho City Enduro 100 event. Discussion ensued.

MINUTES: Minutes for May 26th, 2026 meeting and Special Meeting June 2, 2026 were in front of the Board. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve meeting minutes for May 26th, 2026. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve special meeting minutes for June 2nd, 2026. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes.

DEPARTMENTAL ISSUES: HR Director Dexter came in front of the Board regarding the presence of bats in the Community Justice Building, discussion ensued. Also Ms. Dexter had in front of the Board the Salary Ranges/Changes and Kinds and Levels for the Assessor's position of Roll Clerk and the Prosecuting Attorney's position of Office Manager, with a request to change now due to actively hiring for both these positions, discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve the change for Roll Clerk Kinds & Levels from a 3 to a 5. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve changing the Kinds & Levels for the Prosecuting Attorney's Office Manager from a 6 to a 7. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Ms. Dexter also had in front of the Board the Building Official Qualifications for Planning & Zoning, review and discussion ensued. Assessor Juszcak brought in front of the Board the Board of Equalization Letter for hearings, discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve the Assessor's BOE Letter. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. In front of the Board was a Release of Lien Letter for an Indigent case for signature that was approved on May 26, 2026 meeting. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve signature for the Indigent Release of Lien. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Mr. Braughton had in front of the Board an Auction List of Vehicles no longer in service, review and discussion ensued. Clerk Prisco had in front of the Board the FY2027 Budget for the Commissioners Department, discussion ensued. This will be discussed at the Budget Workshops scheduled for the June 16, 2026 meeting.

CONTRACTS/AGREEMENTS/GRANTS/RESOLUTIONS: Wildfire Mitigation Administrator Jones who was not present, had in front of the Board the EMPG Grant from Idaho office of Emergency Management, review and discussion ensued. Clerk Prisco explained what the grant was and what expenses it covered. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve the Emergency Manager 2025 Sub-recipient Award Agreement. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes. Resolution 2026-25 Burn Ban Season deactivation letter that was approved at the June 2, 2026 meeting. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to approve Resolution 2026-25 a Boise County Resolution Adjusting the County Burn Ordinance Beginning Date for Boise County's 2026 Fire Season. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All ayes.

CORRESPONDENCE: The bills/claims were presented to the Board for review and approval. Discussion ensued. Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to pay the claims in the total amount of \$253,440.76. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED; All Ayes.

PUBLIC HEARING: Chairman Tucker opened the public hearing for VAR 2026-03 Meyers Variance. Planning & Zoning Assistant Morrison discussed the variance for the Meyers that own property, applicants were present. There were no objections from agencies. Public Hearing was noticed up properly. Chairman Tucker opened for applicants, Mr. Theodore Meyers gave a history of the property and what has been done. Commissioner's questions for the applicant ensued. Chairman Tucker opened the public hearing for any public testimony. Mr. Aaron Bell commented on the wall as an easement and need to talk to legal on the matter. Mr. Shawn Lasalle, whose property is adjacent to the Meyer's would like things to be easier with no problems to arise in the future. Chairman Tucker closed the public testimony portion of the public hearing. Commissioners deliberated. Chairman Tucker tabled until June 16, 2026 meeting at 10:00 a.m. for legal to have all documents ready.

Ms. Alicia Baptiste with Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections, District 4 Liaison, along with Community Justice Administrator Leader, presented the annual reports on juvenile probation within the Community Justice Department.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Commissioner Lindstrom MOTIONED to move into executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(b), personnel. Commissioner Callahan SECONDED. Roll call vote: Chairman Tucker – Aye; Commissioner Callahan – Aye. Commissioner Lindstrom - Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Planning & Zoning Assistant Morrison, Planning & Zoning Permit Technician Barnhill, Planning & Zoning Deputy Turner, Planning & Zoning Code Enforcement Officer Watkins and Human Resource Director Dexter were present in first portion of executive session. Second portion of Executive Session 74-206(1)(b) personnel, Human Resource Director Dexter and Prosecuting Attorney Sosa were present. Chairman Tucker brought the meeting out of executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(b), personnel, no action required.

MISCELLANEOUS: Future Agenda Topics were reviewed and discussed
Chairman Tucker adjourned the meeting until the regular meeting of June 16th, 2026.
